In 2020 Blue Mountains City Art Gallery will host the popular *Blue Mountains Portraits* exhibition from **25 January – 22 March 2020.**

The exhibition celebrates the unique and diverse Blue Mountains community. Artists are invited to submit a portrait for consideration. Portraits can be of any Blue Mountains (LGA) community member or a person that has strong connections with the Blue Mountains. We encourage a broad range of styles and media such as paintings, photography, drawing, collages and mixed media.

Please note <u>we do not expect</u> artists to have a work completed before the actual exhibition dates and will accept sketches and concept drawings for selection.

Please note the closing date for submissions is Sunday, 29 September 2019.

Submissions must be complete and include an artist resume of I A4 page and I electronic image (jpg/tiff file, min IMB, max 5MB) of the portrait or concept sketch.

- 1. The submitted portrait must be created and owned by the artist.
- 2. The submitted portrait must be of a Blue Mountains resident (living or deceased) or someone who has strong connections with the Blue Mountains (LGA).
- 3. The submitted portrait must have been created within the last 10 years.
- 4. The portrait must have a recognisable likeness of the subject.
- 5. The portrait subject must be known to the artist and be aware of the artist's intention to enter this work into the *Blue Mountains Portraits* exhibition.
- 6. A limit of I work per artist applies. If the work consists of multiple parts please indicate this in your submissions.
- 7. The Blue Mountains Portraits exhibition will attract large audiences of all ages. Please consider this when composing your work.
- 8. Each artist will be paid an artist fee of \$100 if their work is selected for the exhibition.
- 9. The medium of work is the artist's choice but works can be no bigger than 200cm x 200cm including frame and have a max weight of 30 kg.
- 10. All works must be in a condition ready to hang. All works must be suitably framed or on a board or stretched canvas. D-rings need to be attached to the frame or stretcher.
- II. Artists are responsible for delivering their artworks to the Blue Mountains City Art Gallery during the week of 13 17 January 2020 and collecting their works after the completion of the exhibition from 24 26 March 2020.
- 12. Artists are responsible for arranging appropriate packing of the works prior to transportation.
- 13. Clear identification must appear on back of work including the artist's name, title of portrait, subject's name, medium used, date of work, artist's address and phone number.
- 14. Artists authorise Blue Mountains City Art Gallery to use images of their artwork for promotion of the exhibition. The copyright of the artwork remains that of the artist.
- 15. All artworks in the exhibition will be eligible for the People's Choice Prize of \$1,000 unless the artist notifies the exhibition manager that they do not want to be eligible.
